- Interviewing: "Breaking the Ice", Legal Cases, and Latino Cultural Information. Including how to be an active participant even when the interviewing officer knows little or no Spanish. (Including Latino Surname makeup)
- The participant will be able to conduct a traffic stop, high risk traffic stop and affect an arrest using short phrases and words to reduce your agency's liability. (Based on validation study)
- Precautionary, imminent danger, drug and weapon terminology both literal and slang to increase officer safety. Furthermore, officers will be shown how to use these words and phrases in an interview.
- Accident, DWI preliminary questions, how to perform, recite and defend FST's.
- Preliminary criminal offense report and personal information gathering techniques in order to obtain accurate information using our unique method developed for officers with little knowledge of Spanish language
- Hands-on practical exercises

All of our instructors are current or past law enforcement officers to lend credibility to the program and audience. Tuition is paid for Florida law enforcement officers through a Florida Department of Transportation Grant.
